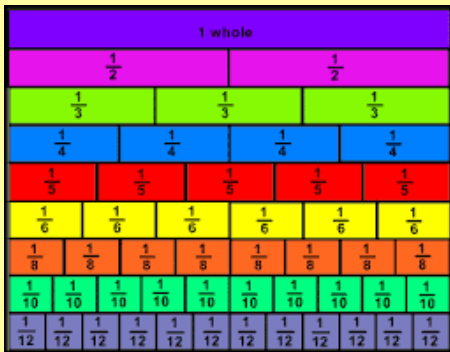

Maths -

Over the term, all children have been working hard to learn their multiplication and division facts.

Please revise the facts you have already learnt, and continue to learn your times tables.

By the end of year 4, all children are expected to know the multiplication and division facts for all tables up to 12.



After Christmas we will be starting work on fractions. You could look at fractions in everyday life (for example, sharing items into halves, thirds, quarters, fifths etc.) Can you remember how to write fractions? Can you find a fraction of a number? What fraction of the tub of Celebrations are Maltesers?

Spellings - Over the Christmas break, please look back at all the spelling patterns you have learnt so far and revise them.

After Christmas, we will be looking at the Year 4 statutory words (see overleaf). You could go through the list and see which you can already spell and begin learning the ones you don't know.

You could use rainbow words, crazy writing, draw a picture, pyramid words, put it in a funny sentence, rap it, etc...

English - As we get nearer to the Christmas holidays, you might be reading some Christmas stories or watching some Christmas films.

Look in newspapers or on the internet (with an adult's help) for book and film reviews. Can you write one about a Christmas book or film you have read or seen recently?
