Maths



We are learning about multiplication and division over the next couple of weeks. We have learnt how to count in 2s, 5s and 10s and will use this skill to count groups of objects. Can you find fun ways at home to practice counting in 2s, 5s and 10s? You could count lots of pairs of shoes (counting in 2s) or lots of fingers (5s and 10s). You could also use 2p, 5p and 10p coins (as a recap following our work on money) to help learn these patterns.

Science



Last week's home learning was to take part in some planting at home. We have had lots of wonderful pictures coming in, of children planting lots of different seeds. For those of you who have planted, your job this week is to take care of them and to give them everything they need to grow.

If you haven't planted anything yet, you could plant something this week, or help family/friends look after their own plants! The weather is going to be improving soon, so those lovely plants will need lots of care and attention.
