Please find below some ideas for guiding your child's learning at home. Please encourage your child to choose and complete at least one task from options, with your support.

Topics this week- Multiplication, senses and I love Pets!

- Count in 2's, 5's and 10's. Can you count forwards and backwards to 20, 50 or 100?
- Go on a senses walk- What can you hear, see, touch, taste or smell?
- Write your own version of "I love Pets" about a pet you have at home or a favourite pet.

A note on reading:

As we are currently unable to issue reading books from school (due to restrictions), all of the children have access to books via *Bug Club* (which can be found on their Wonde dashboard). All of the books have been issued by your child's teacher at the appropriate level. Please let us know if you have any difficulty accessing them.

Please read with your child every night for at least 10 minutes a day. Record any reading in your child's reading record book. Reading three times a week, and recording this in the reading record book (plus remembering to return it on a Monday!) will earn a 'Read to Succeed' ticket. Your child could then win a prize at the end of each half term.

PE kits and summer

Please ensure that your child's PE kit is in school all week. We will be starting to use the field for extra PE sessions so will need kit in school.

We will also be using outside spaces for our learning this term. Please ensure children have a sun hat and named suncream to help protect them from the sun.
